Suggested Equipment:	Rod Wt(s)	6, 7 and/or 8 wt (9' length min.) for Lahontan Cutthroat	
	Line	Floating or intermediate sinking lines; sink tips or shooting heads.	
	Leader	5' to 7' 2x - 0x (10-15lb) or 5' to 7' 20-30lb depending on size of fly	
	Tippet	2' to 3' 8lb to 15lb...big fish that are not leader shy	
	Other	6' ladder with steel footing for weight. Empty 1 Gal. Plastic jug on 6' rope for location float. Ladders are recommended but not required. Must have ID tag attached. (Ask Tom)	
Suggested Flies:	Patterns/Sizes/etc.	Black Wooly Bugger, copper John, Blood midge, Maholo Nymph and midge, Pyramid Lake Balanced Leeches and Minnows, Pyramid Lake Beetle, Pyramid Lake Wooly Buggers	

Other Gear suggestions: Winter Waders, Coats, hats and gloves (be prepared for cold and windy weather. Ladder with metal on bottom legs to keep it from sinking.

Nevada fishing license is **not** required, but you **will need** a tribal permit available at Crosby lodge, Pyramid Lake store. Cost: \$11 per day, or \$28 for 3 days. **10% discount** for 65+ yrs. & military (active, vet or reserves...must show ID)

The Crosby Family will furnish dinner Friday and Saturday "early" evening allowing late fishing until sundown at 8:00 p.m. In the morning the fish are out about 40 yards. As the day goes the fish are nearer to the beach. At 8:00 p.m. they are at the edge of the beach.
