<p><b>Meals provided:</b> Wednesday dinner (for people arriving on Wednesday and going on guided day on Thursday); Thursday breakfast and lunch for those who arrived on Wednesday, and dinner for entire group; Friday breakfast/lunch/dinner, Saturday breakfast/lunch/dinner, Sun breakfast and lunch. Thursday dinner will be potluck style – use signup sheet to indicate what you will bring. Dinners provided by our host at Marble Mountain Ranch in dining hall (Wednesday and Saturday nights)          Everyone must sign up to help with one meal – use signup sheet to select which meal to help</p>			
<b>Fish:</b> Steelhead (most half pounders, some adults)		<b>Fishing strategy:</b> Swinging flies with single handed rods from drift boats; option to wade and swing flies with either single handed or spey rods on non-guided days.	
<b>Suggested Equipment:</b>	<b>Rod Wt(s)</b>	5-8 wt.	
	<b>Line</b>	Sinking type 3-6 or floating with 10-15ft sinktip

<b>Suggested Flies:</b>	<b>Patterns/Sizes</b>	Assassins, herniators, muddler minnows, silver hilton, wooly bugger, brindle bug, skunk, mossback, purple peril, and freight train in sizes 8 - 10 with and without bead heads. Available from most fly shops and also the ranch gift shop.

<b>Details/ Comments</b>			
<b>Drive:</b> 400 miles, plan for 8 hours one way with stops for gas, food, etc.			
<b>Facilities:</b> Two cabins with kitchen/bath that sleep 4 each			
<b>Meals:</b> Included and most prepared by club, two dinners will be provided by our host in dining hall			
<b>Access:</b> 75+ miles of roadside access for walk/wade on non-guided days			
<b>Guide day:</b> 2 persons per boat, 2 to 3 guides per day for 6 maximum guided anglers per day. 16 maximum people guided over 3 days, reserved in advance and included in fee, includes shuttle, lunch, flies as needed. Reserved in pairs only. Guided days: Thursday, 2 boats and 4 anglers; Friday, 2 or 3 boats, 4 to 6 anglers; Saturday, 2 or 3 boats, 4 to 6 anglers.			
<b>Staggered attendance:</b> Those assigned Thursday guide day to arrive 1 day early on Wed, the rest will arrive Thurs.			
<b>Cost/person:</b> \$684 for 3 nights lodging, or \$828 for 4 nights, all food, and 2 days drifting with a guide. For 3 nights but only 1 guided day the cost is \$460. <b>Tips for guides not included.</b>			

**Deposit:** \$100 by August 1st to reserve spot (guide reservations are first come, first served)

**Deadline:** September 15th -- 100% payment due for all attendees

**Cancellation:** Between September 15th and October 1st, 100% refund no restrictions; after October 15th, no refund unless replacement can be found or accommodation can be worked out with lodge owner. 100% refund if river is unfishable and trip is cancelled by Marble Mountain Ranch.

**Comments:** Klamath River provides opportunity to fly fish for wild and hatchery steelhead in a remote setting and minimal crowds. Learn how to fly fish for steelhead by swinging a fly. Fishout venue allows flexibility for all levels, DIY to guided, beginner to expert, walk/wade, guided drift boat, or bring your own boat or raft.
