Only artificial lures with barbless hooks, no bait
01/01 THROUGH 02/28

2 salmon, 1 hatchery trout or 1 hatchery steelhead

03/01 THROUGH 07/31
0 salmon, 1 hatchery trout or 1 hatchery steelhead
08/01 THROUGH 10/15

2 salmon, 1 hatchery trout or 1 hatchery steelhead 10/16 THROUGH 12/31

0 salmon, 1 hatchery trout or 1 hatchery steelhead



## SECTION B

From Daguerre Pt. Dam to the Hwy 20 Bridge Open All Year

Only artificial lures with barbless hooks, no bait 0 salmon, 1 hatchery trout or 1 hatchery steelhead




## SECTION C
