Fishout Details:

The Lower Yuba is an opportunity for wild trout during the classic Skwala hatch located 3 hours from the south bay. Fishout is flexible, come for one or both days, it's entirely up to you, lodging is DIY. Meals provided for two days, Friday and Saturday, includes breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Regulations: Artificial lures with barbless hooks required, catch and release only

Friday – public section (wade or float):

7:00am meet for breakfast at my campsite at Sycamore Ranch campground
 8:00am depart to wade or float river on public section (I plan to float the river in pontoon)
 6:00pm meet for dinner at my campsite

Saturday – private section at UC Davis Research Station (wade only):

7:00am meet for breakfast at my campsite at Sycamore Ranch campground
 8:00am meet at the gate of UC Davis Research Station, see link
 6:00pm meet for dinner at my campsite

Anyone is welcome to join me with their own tent/RV in the campground and/or floating the river on Friday with their own pontoon. Fishout may change or cancel depending on weather or river conditions.

Only artificial lures with barbless hooks, no bait

- 01/01 THROUGH 02/28
2 salmon, 1 hatchery trout or 1 hatchery steelhead
- 03/01 THROUGH 07/31
0 salmon, 1 hatchery trout or 1 hatchery steelhead
- 08/01 THROUGH 10/15
2 salmon, 1 hatchery trout or 1 hatchery steelhead
- 10/16 THROUGH 12/31
0 salmon, 1 hatchery trout or 1 hatchery steelhead



SECTION B

From Daguerre Pt. Dam to the Hwy 20 Bridge

Open All Year

Only artificial lures with barbless hooks, no bait
0 salmon, 1 hatchery trout or 1 hatchery steelhead

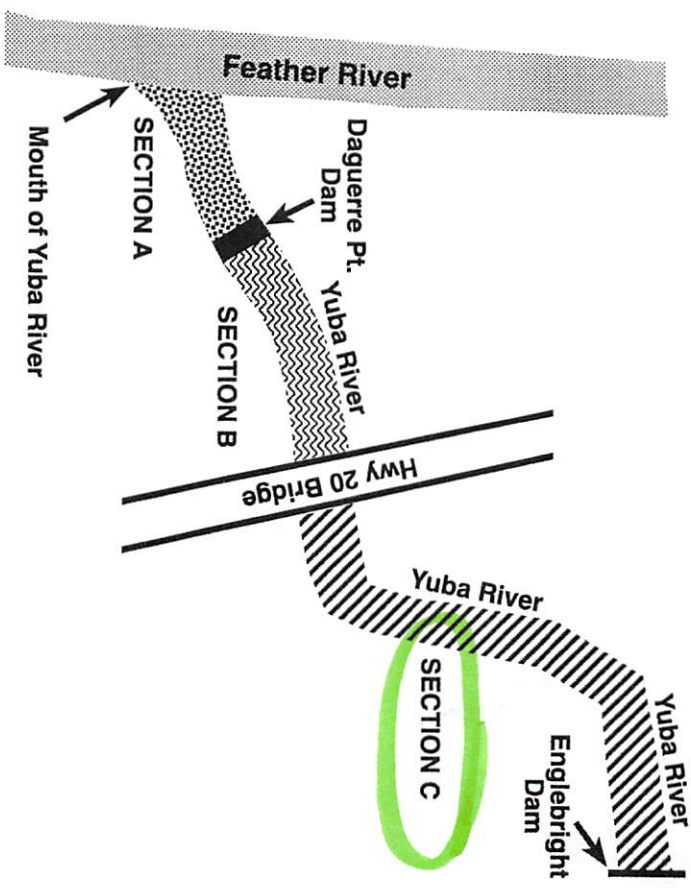

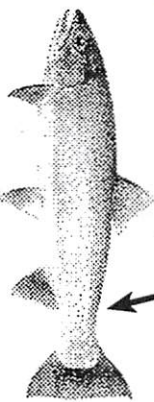
From the Hwy 20 Bridge to Englebright Dam

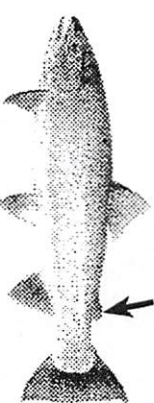
