Details/ Comments (Updates will occur: attendee list, car pooling)

The Trinity River Fishout immediately follows the Klamath River Fishout so one trip to northern California can mesh the two Fishouts. Klamath 11/2 – 11/5; Trinity 11/5 – 11/8. This enables Flycasters to experience two different fisheries, two different Steelhead experiences.

Transportation: Car pools are recommended. It is about five hour drive. 4-wheel drive vehicle is recommended as snow does occur and some access points are rough.

Accommodations: Lowest cost will be with 12 people (one couple in the master bedroom in the Apartment room). Room needs will affect costs. If you want to arrive before or stay after the Fishout dates (in the same rooms) you need to reserve well in advance. Cooking in kitchen in Apartment; breakfast and dinners in small dining area in Apartment. Typically we have two nights of BBQ dinner
