Suggested Flies:	Patterns/Sizes	Assassins, herniators, muddler minnows, silver hilton, wooly bugger, brindle bug, skunk, mossback, purple peril, and freight train in sizes 8 - 10 with and without bead heads. Available from most fly shops and also the ranch gift shop.

Details/ Comments Drive: 400miles, plan for 8 hours one way with stops for gas, food, etc. Facilities: Four cabins #1-4 with kitchen/bath that sleep 3-4 each Meals: Included and most prepared by club, one dinner will be provided by our host in dining hall Access: 75+ miles of roadside access for walk/wade or drift your own boat (\$25 shuttle fee) Guide day: 2 persons/boat, 2 guides/day for 4 max/day, 12 max spread over 3 days, reserved in advance and included in fee, includes shuttle, lunch, flies as needed Other day: Optional 2nd guide day available with the 3rd guide, or DIY with access locations provided Staggered attendance: Those assigned Thur guide day to arrive 1 day early on Wed, pay \$460 for 4 nights, the rest will arrive Thur and pay \$430 for 3 nights Cost/person: \$430 for 3 nights or \$460 for 4 nights lodging, all food, and 1 day drift with guide Add \$210/person for 2nd guide day with 3rd guide, reserved in pairs only Deposit: \$50 ASAP to reserve spot (guide reservations are first come first serve) Deadline: Aug 12, 2015, 100% payment by August club meeting for all attendees Cancellation: Before Aug 12, 100% refund no restrictions – after Aug 12, 100% refund if river is unfishable Comments: Klamath River provides opportunity to fly fish for wild and hatchery steelhead in a remote setting and minimal crowds. Learn how to fly fish for steelhead with a swung fly. Fishout venue allows flexibility for all levels, DIY to guided, beginner to expert, walk/wade, guided drift boat or bring your own.
